Bleed

For borderless edges, extend images, photos and/or solid background colors 1/8" beyond the edge of the page. This area (yellow) will be trimmed during the finishing process. It should not contain any information you intend to be seen or read.

Margin

For best results keep text and images that must be seen and read at least 1/8" from edge of page.
